EMERGENCY ACTION PLANS

Safety Training Handout

EAPS or Emergency Action Plans facilitate employer & employee actions during workplace emergencies, especially building evacuations.



At a minimum an EAP must:

- Outline the means of notifying employees of an emergency
- Outline evacuation procedures
- Map out emergency escape route(s)
- Identify names & job titles of person(s)
 to contact in an emergency
- Determine how employees will be accounted for after an emergency evacuation
- Describe procedures for critical employees
- Describe rescue & medical duties (if applicable)

Smart Safety Rules

- Be sure you review the EAP in each workplace
- Only use a portable fire extinguisher if you are training and authorized to do so by your employer
